Whitby has just been voted Britain's "Best Day Out" and as only the best will do for Midgley we have booked a luxury coach from B&S Coaches. We will be leaving the bus terminus in the middle of the village at 8 am, stopping for refreshments at the Highwayman Café on the way. We then travel to Robin Hood's Bay for those who wish to walk the cliff tops through to Whitby, whilst those wanting a more sedentary day will continue through to Whitby on the coach. The attractions of Whitby are too numerous to list in their entirety but do include the Abbey, the Old Town and Harbour, Fortune's Smokery where kippers and pate can be purchased, the famous Magpie Fish Restaurant or Trencher's Restaurant, as well as the wonderful sands stretching up the coast to Sandsend. The coach will depart Whitby at 5p.m. for return to Midgley. Tickets will be on sale shortly in the shop at £12 for adults and £6 for children 14 years and under.
