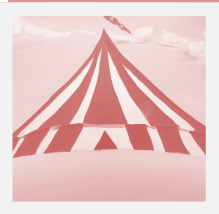

**Extra sowings and cuttings from gardeners out there would also be great for the plant stall.**

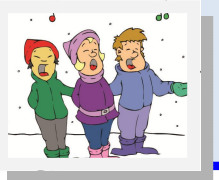
## VILLAGE CAROLS

Last but far from least, thank you SANTA and your helper for finding the time to call in and see us all.

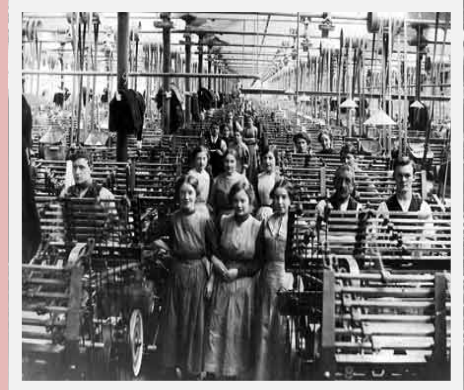

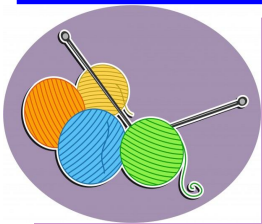
